BACK-TO-SCHOOL SCHEDULE 2022 AT THE LOUIS-QUERBES PAVILION

ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, the regular dress code is mandatory and must respect the standards described in the uniform document. Students must wear black leather shoes (sneakers are not permitted). All students must bring their school physical education clothes for the first day of school.

Bourget College students are beginning Tuesday, August 30th at 8:15 am.

Bourget College students are expected at the side entrance of the Louis-Querbes Pavilion.

The official uniform is required (polo and pants, skirt, or Bermuda shorts).

Please note that no confirmation receipt will be sent due to the large number of documents. Also, if you are sending your application by mail, it is important to send us a photocopy of the document, as we will not return the original.

Bus transportation

Bus routes will be available under MENU/ADMISSION/SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION on our website by mid-August.

Please note that after September 1st, a fee of \$200 per pass will be applied to your invoice for any cancellation of the service or if you deregister. A fixed fee of \$250 per child will be applied for those with two different routes.

Please note that the routes are not necessarily the same as last year. If you plan to move, please inform the Registrar office as soon as possible.

<u> Padlocks - Keys</u>

The student needs two identical numbered combination locks. These locks must be purchased from the College at a cost of \$20. We keep a record of these locks in a file so that we can help students who forget the numbered combination.

A room key is loaned to resident students for a \$5 deposit.
