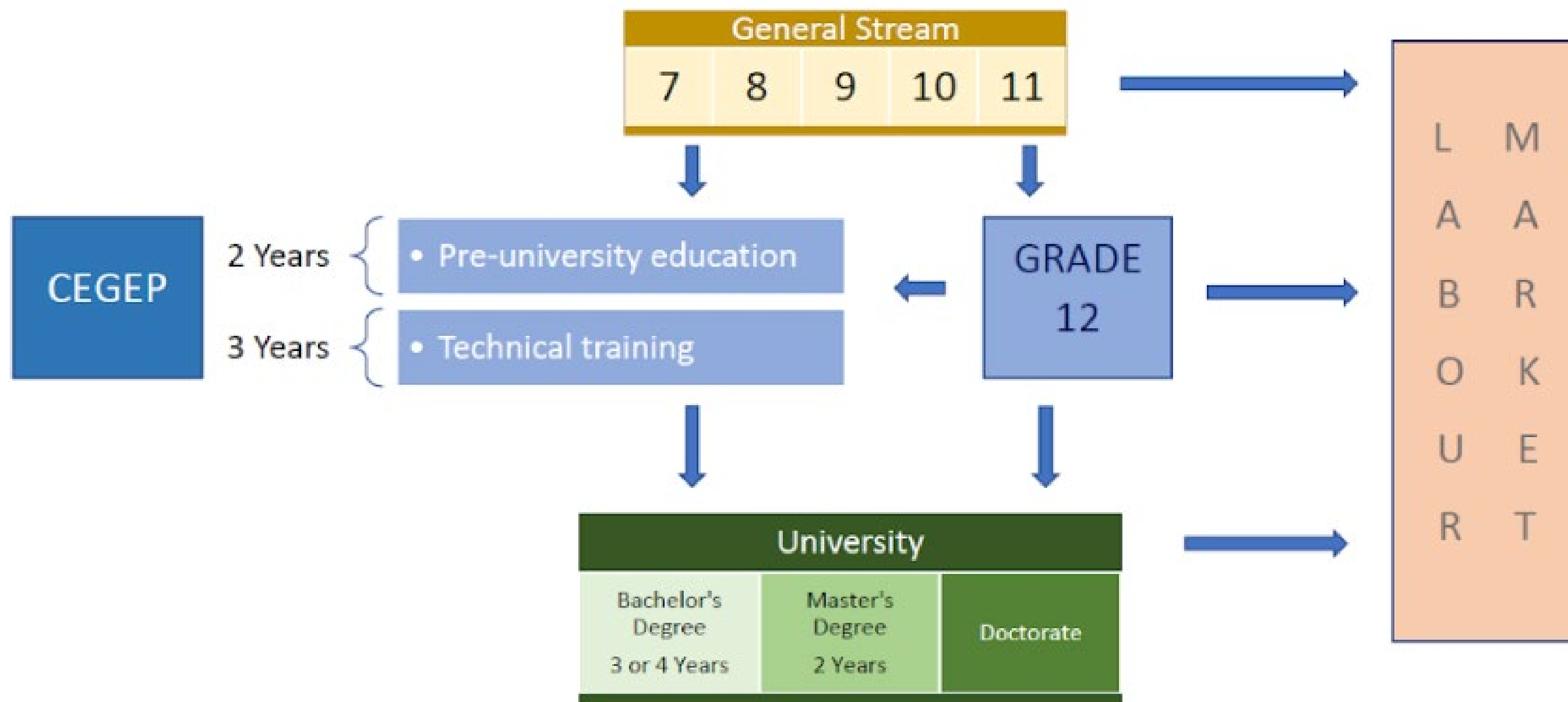
Pedagogical Vision

To obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students must successfully complete:

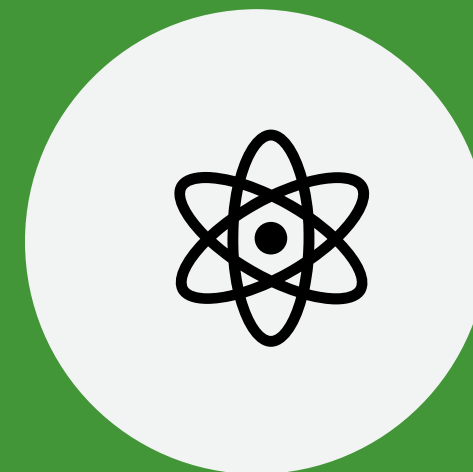
1. 6 pre-university (4U or 4M) courses
