


Pedagogical Vision

The Quebec Education System









- 2. 10 hours of community service.



Bourget College offers a 5-Day or 7-Day residency option


The residence has 115 + single rooms distributed on 2 floors: girls and boys

The 7-Day residents participate in weekend activities and trips






