



Scholarship application and Financial Assitance request

Elite Sports programs

Bourget College has always encouraged athletic development among its students. Proud of a rich heritage and a long tradition of sporting achievements, Bourget College innovates and consolidates its position as a leader in the field of athletics. As a result, the College, its foundation and its various partners have enabled the establishment of a scholarship program to support our students in education. This program will provide students with access to top-notch athletic programs while benefiting from a rich curriculum and quality coaching.

General eligibility

To be eligible for the various scholarships, the Student-Athlete must meet the following conditions:

- Be registered or in the process of enrolling at Bourget College and meet the various admission criteria.
- Respect all the conditions stipulated in the educational contract linking it to Bourget College.
- Be enrolled in one of the College's Elite Sports program.
- Complete the application form for Scholarship and provide supporting documentation.
- Represent Bourget College ethically and citizenly in all circumstances in addition to projecting a positive image among its peers.

Students will be selected by a committee represented by the various partners, according to the criteria in force and according to the different scholarship programs.

In all cases, a departure from the College or an abandonment of the sport would result in disqualifying the Student-Athlete from the amounts allocated. The College reserves the right, at all times, to withdraw scholarship from a student who does not meet the commitments associated with the assistance program.

Eligibility criteria

1- Academic Excellence Scholarship

Objective:

Encourage and highlight the academic success of Student-Athletes committed to their pursuit of sporting excellence.

Other eligibility criteria include:

Beyond the five eligibility criteria mentioned above, the Student-Athlete will be required to:

- Maintain an excellent academic average throughout his school journey.

2- Sports Excellence Scholarship

Objective:

Encourage and highlight the sporting success of Student-Athletes committed to their pursuit of sporting excellence.

Other eligibility criteria include:

Beyond the five eligibility criteria mentioned above, the Student-Athlete will be required to:

- Demonstrate the level of excellence achieved specific to his sport.

3- Leadership and Volunteering Scholarship

Objective:

Encourage and highlight community engagement and leadership skills of the Student-Athletes committed to their pursuit of sporting excellence.

Other eligibility criteria include:

Beyond the five eligibility criteria mentioned above, the Student-Athlete will be required to:

- Demonstrate leadership skills, particularly his ability to positively influence and motivate others
- Be involved in the community beyond his commitment to his sport.

NB: If you wish to apply for a financial assistance only, please complete the attached form and provide the requested financial documents.

Applying for Scholarship

These scholarships are reserved for enrolled students at Bourget College. Student-Athletes or the supported parent must complete the form and send it to: financial@collegebourget.qc.ca.

Mandatory items to provide are:

- The following form filled out properly;
- The latest school report card;
- A cover letter (maximum two pages);
- A letter of recommendation (with reference);
- A letter specifying the type of community engagement, if the application is associated with the leadership award.

Applications will then be forwarded to the selection committee who will follow up and make a decision

The 1st round will take place in **mid-February**.

The 2nd round will take place in **mid-March**.

Thereafter, requests will be analyzed on a case-by-case basis.

Disclosure:

An acknowledgement of your request will be sent to you specifying the date of the selection committee's meeting. Thereafter, a notice informing you of the committee's decision will be emailed to you within 2 weeks of the final decision.

Requirement:

- To be eligible for financial support, the Student-Athlete must attend the College.
- Respect the entire application process.
- Agree to participate in the promotion activities of the College's scholarship program for the following year.

Payment of sholarship:

All scholarships awarded will be applicable to the student's account for the school year that is the subject of the application. The first payment will be made mid-year and the second, at the end of the school year if the student's account is up to date.

Selection process:

The selection committee is made up of four (4) members. These are people who, through their involvement and experience, will be able to ensure a fair and honest analysis of requests:

- The general director of the College
- The director of Financial Services
- The director of the sports sector concerned
- The director of the International and English sector
