BACK-TO-SCHOOL SCHEDULE AUGUST 2023 BOURGET COLLEGE

Bourget College students begin on Thursday August 24th, 2023.

Students must wear black leather shoes (sneakers are not permitted). All students must bring their school physical education clothes for the first day of school.

In the case of a **late arrival**, the student must go to the Student Services office in the Louis-Querbes Pavilion to pick up a late slip before going to class.

If a student needs to **leave early**, he or she must make sure that they have received the exit slip from the Student Services office before leaving the College. They must show it to their teacher before leaving the classroom.

The parent of a student in residency must ALSO notify one of dorm supervisors when leaving after 4:00 p.m. or when absent on an "arrival night".
