Bourget College students will begin at different times this year:

**Grade 9 and 10** – Wednesday August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025

**All students (Grade 9, 10, 11 and 12)** – Thursday August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025

On the first day of school, the regular dress code is mandatory and must respect the standards described in the uniform document (polo and pants, skirt, or Bermuda shorts). Students must wear black leather shoes. All students must bring their school physical education clothes for the first day of school.

Please note that after September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, a fee of \$350 per pass will be applied to your invoice for any cancellation of the service or if you leave the college. A fixed fee of \$450 per child will be applied for those with two different routes.

Please note that the routes are not necessarily the same as last year. If you plan to move, please inform the Registrar office as soon as possible.

### **Padlocks and Lockers**

Students require two combination padlocks for their lockers. Padlocks are available for purchase at "La Zone" at the Pavillon Principal. Students will be assigned their individual locker which must be locked with a combination padlock.

## Absence/Early Dismissal/Late Arrival at Louis Querbes Pavillion
