Bourget College students will begin at different times this year:

Grade 9 and 10 – Thursday August 27th, 2026

Grade 9, 10, 11 and 12 – Friday August 28th, 2026

On the first day of school, the regular dress code is mandatory and must respect the standards described in the uniform document (polo and pants, skirt, or Bermuda shorts). Students must wear black leather shoes. All students must bring their school physical education clothes for the first day of school.

On the first day of school, all Bourget College students are expected to meet outside at the back of the Louis-Querbes Pavilion.

Bus transportation

Please note that after August 27th, 2026, a fee of \$350 per pass will be applied to your invoice for any cancellation of the service or if you leave the college.

A fixed fee of \$600 per child will be applied for those with two different routes. Effective August 27th, 2026, these fees are non-refundable in the event of cancellation or withdrawal. The annual pass fee will be based on the address farthest from the school.

If you plan to move, please notify the Registrar's Office as soon as possible at registrar@cbourget.ca



Students who do not have an annual pass may use the transportation service on an occasional basis ONLY if seats are available. Your child must register online and MUST go to the school store (La Zone) to validate their registration.

The 6:30 p.m. transportation service will be offered at a cost of \$315 for an annual pass, and registration will take place at the beginning of the school year via the portal. Additionally, daily registration on the Voltigeurs website will remain in effect to reserve a seat for your child each time they use the 6:30 p.m. transportation service. Absence/Early Dismissal/Late Arrival
