







Pedagogical Vision

QUEBEC SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA

GRADES 10 AND 11 REQUIREMENTS

To receive the Quebec Secondary School diploma, students must meet all the requirements below:

Accumulate 54 credits in Grades 10 and 11, including 20 from the Grade 11.

Achieve the following Grade 10 courses:

- Mathematics (6 credits)
- Science and technology (4 credits)
- History of Quebec and Canada (4 credits)
- Drama (2 credits)

Achieve the following Grade 11 courses:

- English Language Arts (6 credits)
- French as a Second Language (4 credits)
- Physical Education or Ethics and Religious Culture (2 credits)

Quebec Ministry of Education exams must be written in the following subjects:

- Grade 10 Mathematics, History and Science
- Grade 11 English and French

Science Profile: Physics and Chemistry with Mathematics SN

Prerequisites -

- Grade 10 Mathematics SN achieve an average of 75% or above from terms one and two.
- Grade 10 Science and Technology achieve an average of 75% or above from terms one and two.
- Grade 10 Environmental Science (EST) achieve an average of 65% or above from terms one and two.

Social Studies Profile: Media and Politics with Mathematics CST or SN

Prerequisites – Math SN requires a minimum 60% in Grade 10 Math SN and teacher recommendation.




