SECONDAIRE FRANCOPHONE

Note a: The registration fee includes all types of communication and administrative work. The amount is non-refundable even if the student is absent or leaves over the course of the year. If the study permit request is rejected, a refund of \$1 000 will be granted upon presentation of the rejection letter from the embassy.

Note b: Apart from the tuition fees, this amount includes the membership to the Parents Association and the related fees (students fund, educational material).

Note c: The accommodation is provided from the beginning of the school year until the end of the school year, except for the Christmas holidays. Meals and laundry services are included in the accommodation fees.

Note d: This amount applies to activities such as “Snow Day”, ski nights, fitness training and other activities off the premises of the institution (Arbraska, waterpark, cyclo-camping, ...).

Note e: This \$4000 deposit is used to cover some of the following charges: medical care, medication, refresher courses, short trips, additional transportation, school uniform (approximately \$ 500), legalization of report card (\$ 125), as well as other expenses that may arise over the course of the year. The part that will not have been used will be transferred back to you or kept in the account if the student is readmitted. If there are extra expenses, they will be charged to you. (see details on page 3)

Note f: The immersion classes are mandatory for allophones struggling in French. The courses for beginners are given 3 to 4 times a week. Customized classes may be considered for the second and third years to complete the immersion process.

Note g: If you ask the College Bourget to buy the iPad (around \$850), it will belong to the student. It includes the installation of the needed software and the services of the computer technician. If instead the student brings his own iPad (at least an iPad 9th generation), around \$ 130 will be charged for reinitializing the device and required applications.

The College may send out invoices for expenses that may not have been included (remedial courses or supplementary courses, special activities, trips, optional participation in the Passions program, including the elite sports, and much more).

N.B.: Foreign students must have Quebec health insurance. It must be purchased before leaving their country. We can purchase insurance for you, for around 725\$. You must provide proof of insurance when you get to school. An American visa is advised for shorts trips with school.

Registration should be done before March. After this date, fewer places are available.

DEPOSIT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
