# SECONDAIRE FRANCOPHONE

## Note a (Registration Fees):

- The amount is non-refundable even if the student does not come or leaves over the course of the year. It includes the Quebec Acceptance Certificate application process.

If the Quebec Acceptance Certificate or the study permit request is denied, a refund of CAD \$1,000 will be granted upon presentation of the refusal letter from the provincial or federal Immigration Ministry.

## Note b (Tuition Fees):

- This amount includes the Parents Association membership, the Students Fund (for on-campus school activities) and educational material.

## Note c (7-day boarding):

- Based on a single room. Meals, extracurricular activities within the boarding school, and laundry services are included in the accommodation fees. Accommodation is provided for the whole school year except for the two-week break over the December Holidays.

## Note d (Activities):

- This amount covers various on-campus activities (i.e. fitness training, Halloween, workshops, cooking, events and shows, etc.) as well as excursions such as ski day, waterpark, zipline, camping, movies, amusement park, apple picking, sugar shack, Montreal tours, etc.

## Note e (Deposit):

- The deposit is used to cover some of the following expenses: school uniform, laptop, insurance coverage, medical care, medication, refresher courses, legalization of report card (CAD \$200), additional transportation as well as other expenses that may arise over the course of the school year. *See page 3 for more information. What is not spent on the deposit will be returned or will be kept in your account if the student is readmitted.*

## Note f (French Immersion Class):

- French immersion classes are mandatory for beginner level students. These courses are given 3 to 4 times a week. Extra classes may be considered for the second and third years to complete the immersion program.

## CAD \$4,000 DEPOSIT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

It can be used to cover some of the following charges:

### UNIFORM

Expect to spend approx. CAD \$500-600 through our supplier or approx. CAD \$200-300 at our second-hand store.

### iPad or laptop (Secondary 3-5)

Bourget College had been using the iPad as its prime educational tool for many years.

Students may bring their own iPad. It must be at least a 9th generation iPad.

Please note that the school has begun a transition to **laptop** use, so laptops are recommended.

A laptop computer may be purchased through the College (model and cost to be announced).

A fee of CAD \$140 will be charged to reset and configure your device for the school.

### INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE

Approximately CAD \$750. Foreign students must have Quebec health insurance coverage. It must be purchased before leaving the country. The College can purchase the insurance for you. You must provide proof of insurance upon your arrival.

### OTHER

School supplies, medical care, medication, refresher courses, special activities, additional transportation, legalization of report card (CAD \$200), etc.

## OPTIONAL FEES
