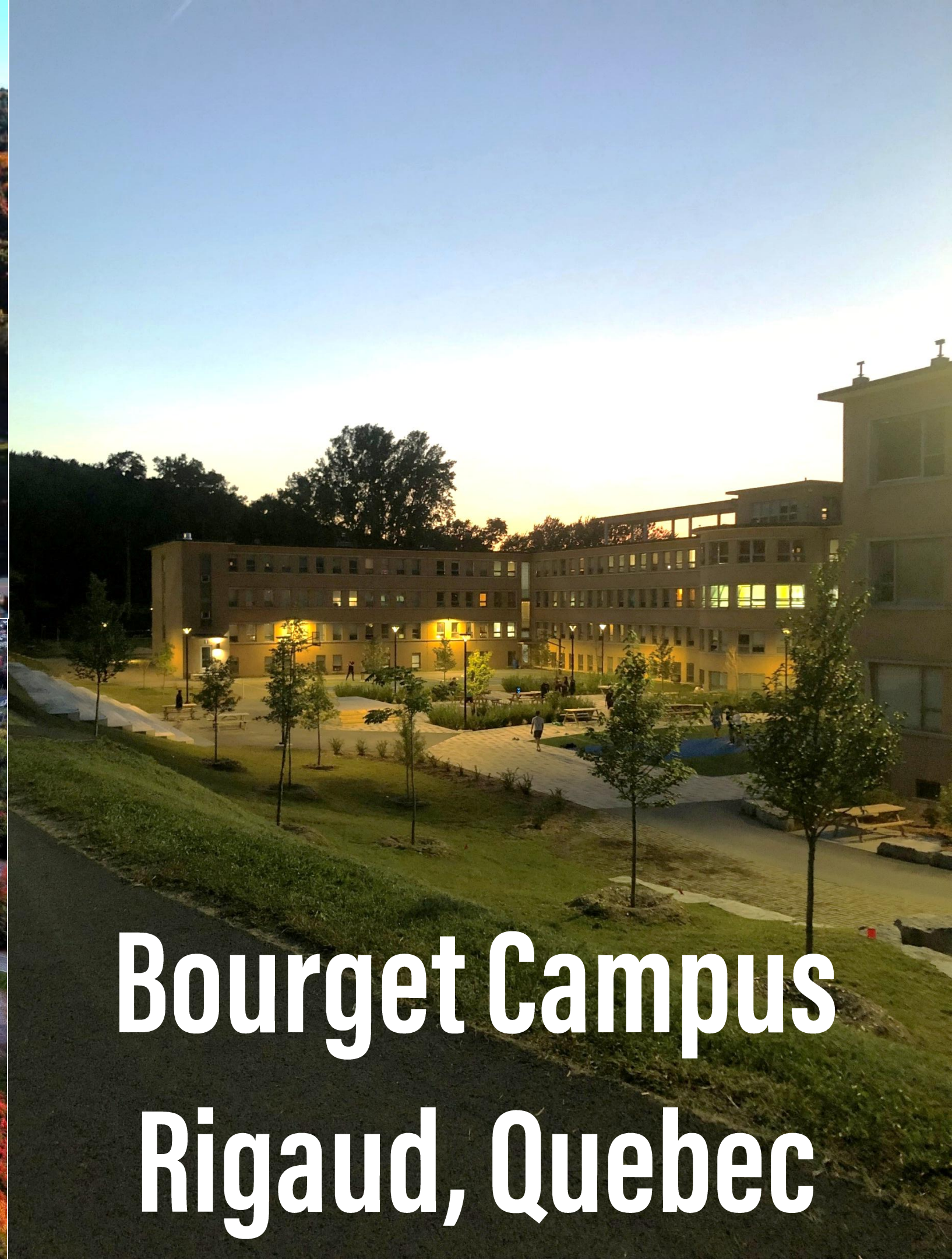

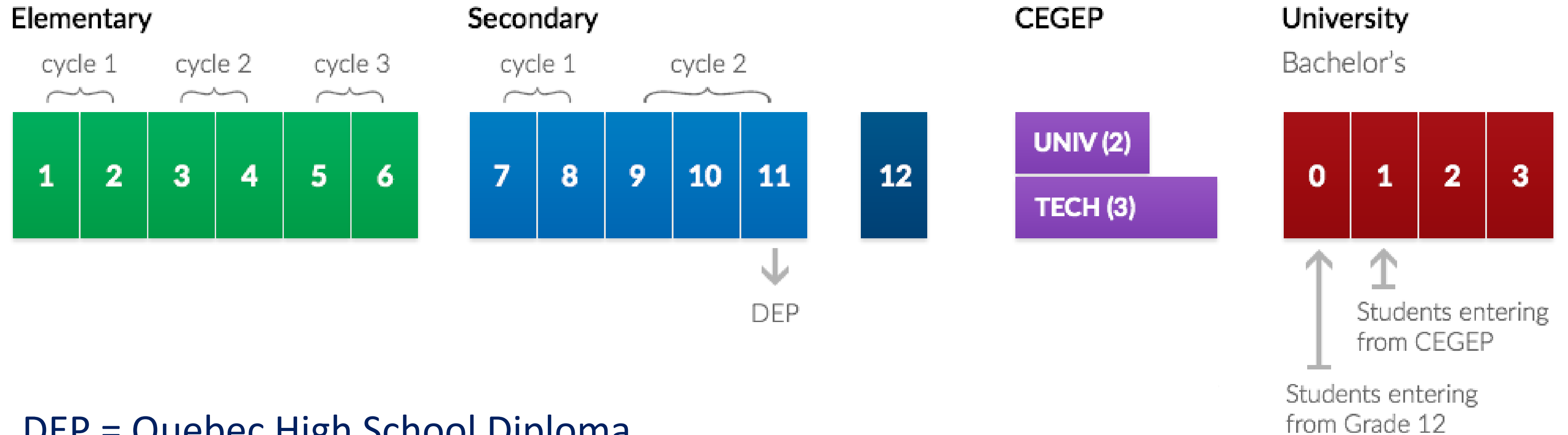

The Quebec Education System



DEP = Quebec High School Diploma

Grade 12 at Bourget = Ontario Secondary School Diploma

CEGEP = Preuniversity College

- Students in all Canadian provinces attend high school from Grade 9 to Grade 12.
- Grade 12 does not exist in the Quebec education system.
- At Bourget College, Grade 12 students complete the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).
- The Ontario Secondary School Diploma has a very strong reputation around the world.
- Students can choose to study in a Science, Business or Social Studies profile at Bourget.
- English, Math, Science and Business courses are taught by Bourget College teachers. Elective courses are completed with the Ontario Virtual School teachers.

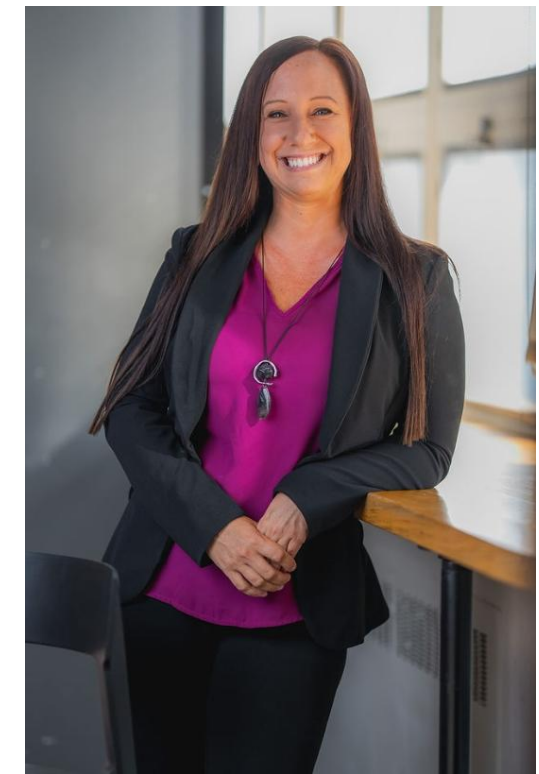

To obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students must successfully complete:

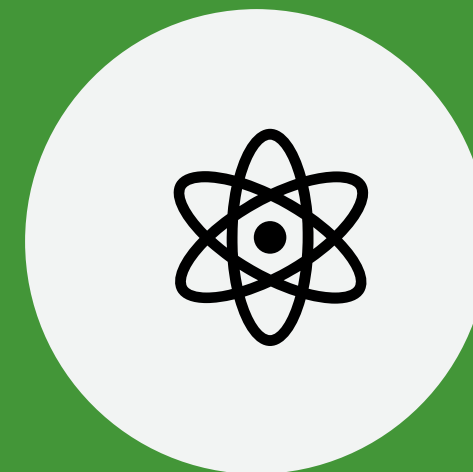
1. A minimum of 6 pre-university (4U or 4M) courses

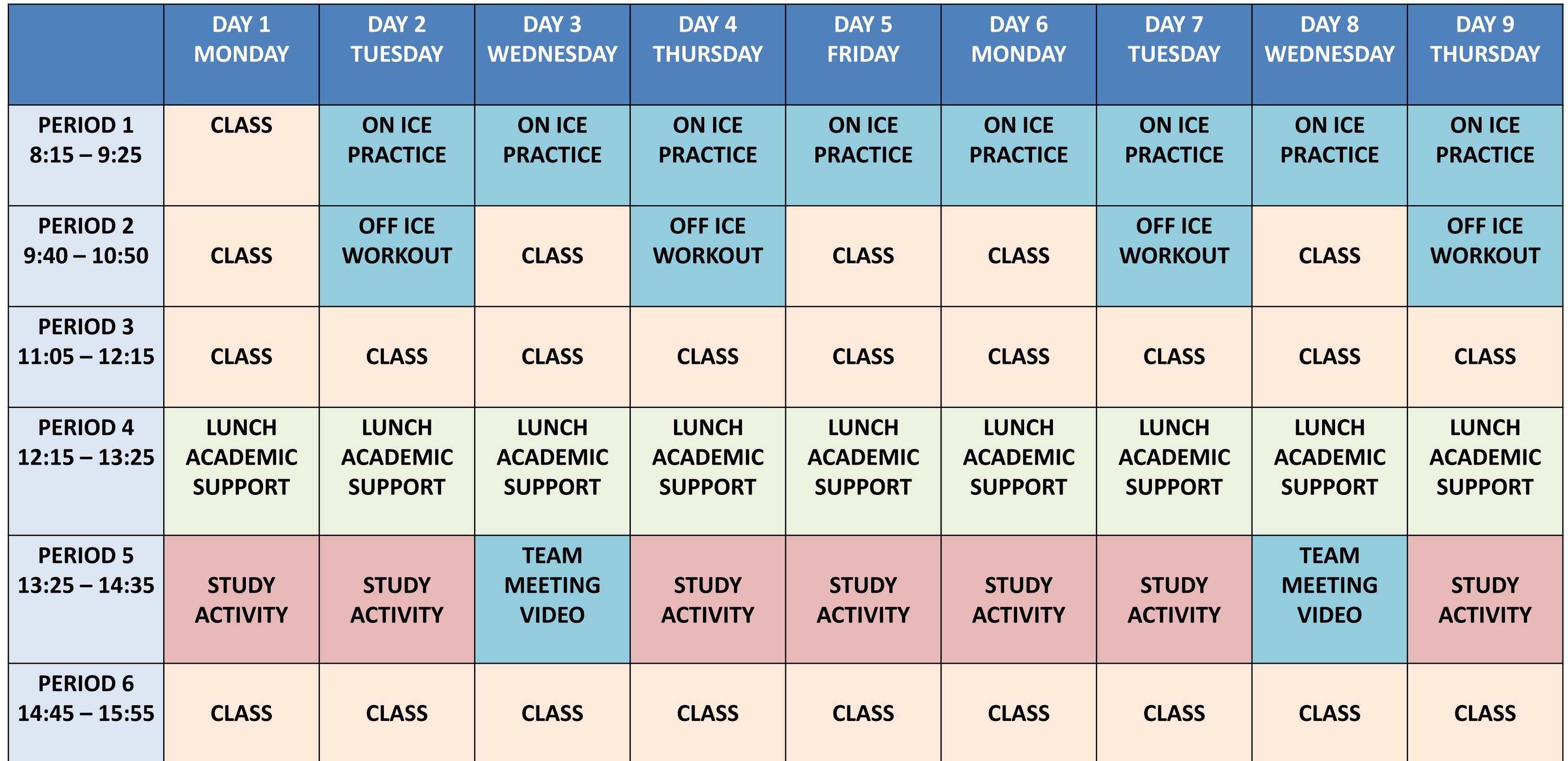

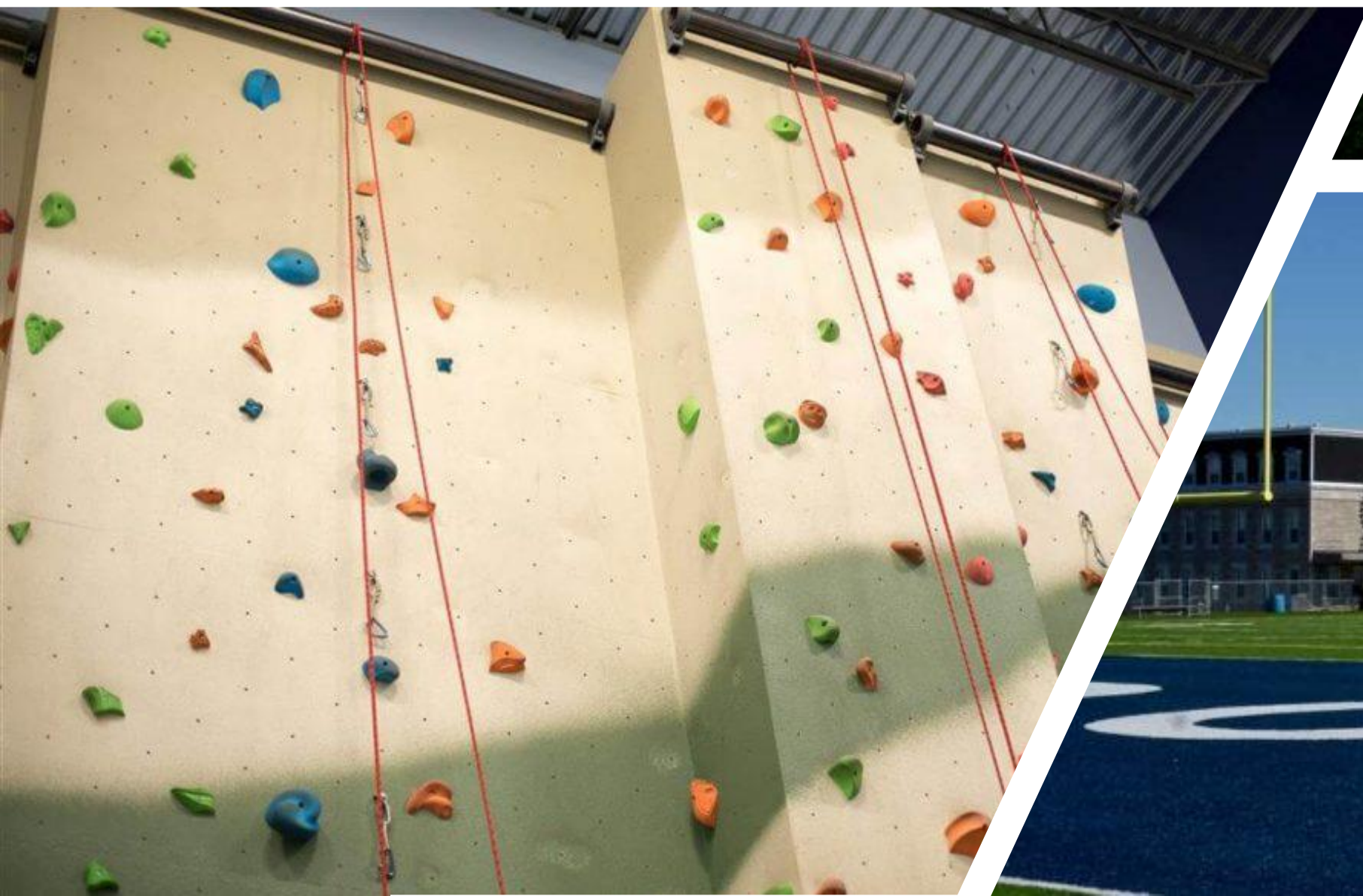
