PAYMENT TERMS

Note a:

Outside the tuition fees, this amount includes the membership for the Parents Association and the related fees (students fund, reading books, educational material and exercise books). An amount of **\$4,900** will be added to these fees for a Canadian Student that was born and lives outside the province of Quebec if he is not resident at the Bourget College.

Note b:

The accommodation is provided all week long. Meals and laundry service are included in the accommodation fees. It also includes activities such as ski nights, fitness training, volleyball, basketball and also some activities outside the premises of the institution (for example: snow day, Arbraska, waterpark, cyclo-camping, end of year trip, etc.).

UNIFORM

Expect about \$500 with our supplier Trium or about \$200 with our thrift shop.

LAPTOP (grade 12)

- Lenovo ThinkPad T480;
- Includes carrying bag, battery, power cable and mouse.

Approximately \$1,650 on purchase or lease for one year at \$500.

IPAD (grade 9-11)

- 7th generation 128 go, minimum;

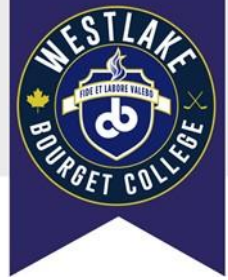
