**Note a:** Outside the tuition fees, this amount includes the membership for the Parents Association and the related fees (students fund, educational material).

**Note b:** The accommodation is provided all week long. Meals and laundry service are included in the accommodation fees. It also includes activities such as ski nights, fitness training and also some activities outside the premises of the institution (for example: snow day, Arbraska, waterpark, cyclocamping, etc.).

Note c: We provide homestay family during weekends and holidays.

**NB:** Foreign students must have health insurance. It must be bought before leaving their country. You can visit an international insurance company such as Ingle International or use your own, if you have one. We can also purchase an insurance for you, for \$500. You must provide proof of insurance when you get to school. An American visa is advised for short trips with school or host family.

## **DEPOSIT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

All financial figures are in Canadian dollars

This amount of \$4,000 is a deposit. For example, it can be used to cover some of the following charges:

#### **UNIFORM**

Expect about \$500 with our supplier Trium or about \$200 with our thrift shop.

**CAQ AND STUDY PERMIT:** \$600

**SINGLE ROOM**: \$565 (depending on availability)

**BUS TRANSPORTATION:** \$1,100

**INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE: \$500** 

Medical care, medication, refresher courses, short trips, additional transportation, school

supplies, etc.: Variable cost

## iPad (grade 10-11)

- 7<sup>th</sup> generation 128 go;
- Includes a protective pouch, Apple Care warranty (4 years) and some applications.
- Buy it from school between \$800 and \$900.

The student can also bring his own iPad. \$130 will be asked to reinitiate and configure it for the school.
