170 YEARS OF HISTORY



On November 12, 1850, at the request of Archbishop Ignace Bourget of Montreal, the first three clerics of St-Viator arrived in Rigaud to begin the great adventure of the "Collège de Rigaud", which would be renamed College Bourget.

Our three valiant warriors departed from Joliette: by horse-drawn carriage to Montreal and by steamboat to the Grand Quai. A two-day trip! We are far from today's transportation.

Bourget has continuously adapted its services to meet the needs of the students who have come through its doors: School commissioners' school, elementary and secondary school, business courses in English, science courses, classical courses, welcoming girls, college courses, a large dormitory, international students, school transportation organized in the greater region, introduction of the preschool and elementary sectors. Its latest achievement: the high school program in English with a 12th grade, leading to the Ontario diploma...

Thanks to a team of experienced and committed educators, the College offers an educational program that develops all areas of the individual. Opened in the 19th century, it is well into the 21st century... and hopes, thanks to you, to be there in the 22nd century!
